#### Abstract Guidelines

Abstracts are invited for both oral and poster presentations at the Forum. A limited number of abstracts will be selected for oral presentations by a review panel. Abstracts which address the following criteria are invited for both oral and poster presentations:

1. Abstracts should describe a health service model or project in WA which clearly describes the development and/or implementation of either health policy or best practice guidelines in the context of respiratory health, such as the existing Models of Care of the Respiratory Health Network.
2. Abstracts should describe the evidence-base underlying the project or service model.
3. Evaluation of the service model or project should be included, or a description of how the project may be evaluated.

Abstracts should not exceed 250 words, should be typeset using a 12 point Arial font, and should be structured as: Title, Background and aims, Methods, Results and Conclusions.

Authors' full names, affiliations and contact details should be included after the title. Abstracts may be submitted using this form.
